

Opinions Authored

The first table indicates how many majority/lead opinions a justice authored in cases decided by each of the four possible majority vote totals.¹ The second table shows how many concurrences and dissents each justice wrote. Eight justices appear in the tables, as Justice William Callow replaced Justice Robert Hansen on January 3, 1978.
