² In *Schneck v. Mutual Service Casualty Ins. Co.* (23 Wis. 2d 649), Justice Beilfuss wrote the majority opinion but dissented from the result. I credited him with a majority opinion but counted his vote as a dissent. He did not write a *separate* dissenting opinion, but within the majority opinion he devoted a few paragraphs to explaining why he dissented. So, I will credit him with authoring a dissent as well.

Agreement Among Pairs of Justices

The following tables show the percentage of decisions in which every possible pair of justices found themselves on the same side—either both in the majority or both dissenting. The first table covers all 293 decisions; the second table narrows its focus to decisions that were not unanimous. When reading the *second* table, for instance, one finds that Justices Wilkie and Fairchild voted together in 74% of the decisions, while the figure for Justices Dieterich and Currie was 47%.
