

WISCONSIN SUPREME COURT DECISIONS, 1928-29

Four-to-Three Decisions

There were no 4-3 decisions this term—an extremely unusual development, primarily due to Justice Vinje's unavailability explained in this post's introduction. Had he been able to participate, the four decisions deadlocked by 3-3 votes (*In re Relocation of County Highway J*, *Gooder v. State*, *In re Will of Ott*, and *State ex rel. Dammann v. Ballard*) would have generated 4-3 outcomes.
