

Frequency in the Majority

These tables display how frequently each justice voted in the majority. The first table includes all cases in which a justice voted, while the second table includes only cases decided by split votes.¹

All Cases

| Rosenberry | 375 | 376 | 99.7% |
| Stevens | 372 | 375 | 99% |
| Owen | 374 | 379 | 99% |
| Eschweiler | 361 | 379 | 95% |
| Doerfler | 378 | 378 | 100% |
| Vinje | 378 | 378 | 100% |

Non-Unanimous Decisions

| Justice | Majority Votes Cast | Total Votes Cast | Percent in Majority |
|------------|---------------------|------------------|---------------------|
| Crownhart | 22 | 29 | 76% |
| Rosenberry | 28 | 29 | 97% |
| Stevens | 26 | 29 | 90% |
| Owen | 24 | 29 | 83% |
| Eschweiler | 11 | 29 | 38% |
| Doerfler | 28 | 28 | 100% |
| Vinje | 29 | 29 | 100% |

¹ As explained in this post's introduction, it seems unlikely that Justice Vinje actually participated in 378 decisions. However, we can be confident that he did not *dissent* in any of the cases in which he did take part.
